General Cleaning Instructions

Note	Details		
Routine Cleaning	STEP 1	Protect furniture and fixtures from dust and dirt, cover exposed areas with a dust sheet. If the ceiling hasn't been cleaned for a while, it's advisable to wear eye protection and a dust mask to prevent eye irritation and inhalation of dust and dirt. If the tiles are accessible and it is safe to do so, you may remove them from the ceiling grid to ensure thorough and safe cleaning.	
	STEP 2	Remove any loose dust and dirt using a duster or vacuum cleaner. Brush with an anti-static duster, paying particular attention to corners and cobwebs.	
	STEP 3	USE a mild dishwashing detergent diluted in warm water to remove greasy marks. Dab wait and wipe away. Final wipe down with a clean dry cloth (microfibre cloth for best results)	
	Ⓢ	DO NOT use solvents, strongly acidic or alkaline cleaners.	Claims arising from damaged, dull, or etched surfaces are not protected under warranty
	Ⓢ	DO NOT use commercial cleaning agents as they can contain higher concentrations of strong chemicals	Claims arising from damaged or etched surfaces are not protected under warranty
	Ⓢ	DO NOT use waxes or polishes as they can change the surface gloss level	Claims arising from damaged or etched surfaces are not protected under warranty
	Ⓢ	DO NOT use any product containing bleach, ammonia, or any solvents or thinners	Claims arising from damaged or etched surfaces are not protected under warranty
Managing Splashes	Ⓢ	DO NOT use abrasive cleaners – even those in paste, liquid or powder form – as they will mark the surface	Claims arising from damaged or etched surfaces are not protected under warranty
	Ⓢ	DO NOT use magic eraser or pink stuff to clean the decorative panel surface as this may result in burnishing or abrasion.	Claims arising from burnished or abraded surfaces are not protected under warranty
Removing Stubborn Surface Stains	Ⓢ	IMMEDIATELY clean spills that contain strong pigments or colourants (artificial or natural),	Claims arising from staining due to artificial or natural pigments are not protected under warranty
	Ⓢ	IMMEDIATELY clean spills that contain chemicals (artificial or natural), that can etch the surface,	Claims arising from chemical surface damage are not protected under warranty
Water Marks	IMPORTANT		
	Please note that the use of bleach or abrasive cleaners may irreversibly damage the decorative surface. The warranty will not protect against surface damage from these cleaning methods, caution is advised.		
	Ⓢ	If a stain cannot be removed with warm soapy water, try Methylated spirits or Isopropyl Alcohol. Dab the stain, leave for 3 minutes then wash off with water and dry. Finish off with a clean dry cloth (microfibre cloth for best results).	
	The minerals in water that might come from condensation, plant or HVAC equipment may leave visible trace marks, particularly on dark surfaces. Always dry water from surfaces with a clean dry cloth. Microfibre cloths are particularly effective for simple routine maintenance of this condition.		





Preventative Maintenance

Note	Details	
Prevention Tips	IMPORTANT In caring for your decorative surfaces, prevention is the best way to look after your investment	
Dark Surfaces	Darker colours will show scratches & and markings more readily than lighter colours and therefore require more care and maintenance	
Preventing Scratches	Ⓜ	DO NOT use scouring pads, metal brushes, steel wool or abrasive/gritty cleaners (even those in paste, liquid or powder form) as they will damage the surface.
	Ⓜ	Duct tape and masking tape should be carefully removed from the decorative surface without using any metal or sharp implements.
	Ⓜ	DO NOT drag or slide objects (including trade equipment, lifting equipment etc.) across the surface.
Preventing Heat Damage	Ⓜ	DO NOT place or allow hot objects, electrical appliances, welding equipment onto or touching the decorative surface. Where heat generating activities are required to take place adjacent to the wall surface, protective heat deflective shield must be used.
Preventing Chemical Damage	Ⓜ	DO NOT use any of the following products to clean or permit contact with your Laminex decorative surface: Commercial Cleaning Products, Undiluted bleach, Thinners, Turpentine, Graffiti Cleaners (including Easy-Off BAM, Muck Off), Ammonia, Acetone, Petrol, Acids, Rust & Limescale Remover including CLR
	Ⓜ	Pest spray or room deodoriser (aerosol) overspray. First clean with just water on a clean cloth. If stain has been left to dry for an extended period, gently spot clean with methylated spirits
